## RACE DAY RULES

- Entrants must be registered and signed in
- Entrants and trolleys must pass final safety check on the day
- Officials on duty must be obeyed at all times
- Officials will be responsible for starting trolleys
- Drivers will keep their hands and feet on trolleys at all times
- Drivers deliberately crashing into safety barriers will be disqualified.
- Drivers must race in a straight line from start to finish.
- Drivers must remain at finishing line until released by the judges.
- Officials may remove or exclude any competitor if they are not obeying the rules.

# FRANKLIN TROLLEY DERBY

Welcome to the Franklin Trolley Derby 2008. This event will run in conjunction with the Waiuku Classic Festival on Sunday 23 November 2008.

Entry to the Franklin Trolley Derby is by cold coin donation payable on the day by entrants and for non participants Waiuku Classic Festival entry fees will apply. Parking will be available at Waiuku Primary School grounds this is located at the lower end of Queen Street and entry for participants and trolleys is on Belgium Street directly off Queen Street for maps or more directions please contact the organisers.

## Race Categories

### Junior Class

Age 5 to 8 years old  
Maximum wheel diameter 300mm  
Must have effective brakes  
Safety equipment must be worn  
Competing for a cup

### Intermediate Class

Age 9 to 11 years old  
Maximum wheel diameter 300mm  
Must have effective brakes  
Safety equipment must be worn  
Competing for a cup

### Senior Class

Age 12 to 14 years old  
Maximum wheel diameter 300mm  
Must have effective brakes  
Safety equipment must be worn  
Must be purpose built for Trolley Racing  
Competing for a cup

*A trophy will be awarded to the best "Soapbox" designed trolley (this is essentially a trolley of wooden construction).*

### Interschool challenge

Out of the junior, intermediate and senior class the fastest trolleys will be chosen from each school to make a rally team for the final. This race is for the Franklin Interschool Cup.

### Super Modified Class

This is an open class event with no wheel restrictions  
Minimum drivers age of 14 years old  
Must have effective brakes  
Safety equipment must be worn  
A trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of this class.

### Themed or Novelty Class

This is an anything goes class where emphasis is on fun entertainment. It would suit corporate, special interest or even student groups. Trolley's must have effective brakes and participants must wear safety equipment. The winner is not necessarily the fastest, this will be determined at the discretion of the organisers for effort, crowd entertainment and other intangibles (bribery). A trophy will be awarded.

## Rules

- All Trolleys and competitors must pass final safety inspection before being qualified to race. All children must be under parent supervision on race day.

## Requirements

- Trolleys must run on at least three wheels.
- Trolley brakes will be compulsory.
- Gravity is the only power source.
- No supermarket trolleys or go karts with motors removed.
- Angle turn no more than 20° either direction.
- Wheels shall be no greater than 300mm in diameter for restricted wheel class.

## Safety Requirements

Entrants must wear a helmet, protective clothing long pants, long sleeved top and wear covered footwear i.e. **NO BARE SKIN.**

The organisers strongly recommend crash or BMX helmets, overalls, gloves, safety pads and covered shoes.
